INTERNATIONAL A-LEVEL (IAL)

The Internationally Recognised British Pre-University Qualification

A-Levels are recognised by all leading universities worldwide as valid indicators of academic achievement and potential.

In many cases, it may be possible to transfer credits obtained in International A-Level examinations to degree programmes in the USA, thereby gaining complete or partial exemption from the first year of study.

Insworld students usually take three or sometimes four subjects at A-Level. Insworld teaches programmes leading to Pearson Edexcel International A-Level exams. These are **modular in design**, rather than the traditional linear approach. **Each subject is divided into a number of discrete units which are taught separately and examined separately.** This can reduce the exam stress students may feel, and gives us the possibility to adapt the timing of examinations to match the particular situation of each student.

Students can take exams when they are ready to get the best results. There are **two main IAL exam series each year** (in January and May/June). This means that typically, IAL students will take their exams over three separate series. This can spread the pressure of exams more evenly over the duration of the programme, and also allow students to take exams shortly after they have finished studying the material that is to be tested. This can often lead to better learning and better grades.

INTERNATIONAL GCSE (IG)

Internationally Recognised and Benchmarked to UK academic standards

The Pearson Edexcel International General Certificate of Secondary Education is the international equivalent of the UK GCSE exam, the standard year 11 qualification in the UK. It is **benchmarked to UK academic standards**, and is recognised as equivalent to UK GCSE exams **and Singapore-Cambridge GCE O-Level exams**.

The International GCSE curriculum is designed to encourage students to think critically and acquire problem-solving skills while broadening their subject knowledge. The format of the International GCSE exam is designed to be more accessible to international learners studying in Singapore; offering a syllabus based on the British model, but with a wider, more global perspective.

The International GCSE provides a **strong foundation** for higher level courses like IAL/GCE A-Level. Insworld provides a comprehensive International GCSE programme, offering students the opportunity to select the subjects that are right for them, and which will help them as they move forward in their education careers.

Junior Secondary Programme Benchmarked to the UK National Curriculum (Key Stage 3)

The EITP is based on the Pearson Edexcel Lower Secondary Programme and is benchmarked to Key Stage 3 of the UK National Curriculum. The EITP has been designed to give students a strong background in Maths and the Sciences, as well as providing an introduction to the study of humanities.

The EITP **provides students with a solid grounding in the basics of the subjects** they will go on to study at the International GCSE level.

In addition, students receive essential training in academic and study skills. English language support is available for those who need it.

On successful completion of an EITP course, students will be prepared to **progress to the International GCSE programme.**

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC STUDY (EAS)

English Language and Academic Skills Integrated Programme

The Insworld English for Academic Study (EAS) course is an **integrated language and academic skills** programme that focuses on developing the English Language skills and study skills that are essential for academic progress at Insworld Institute.

The Insworld EAS programme is intended for students who have not achieved the minimum English Language level required to join an EITP, International GCSE, or A-Level programme. The EAS programme places equal emphasis on the **four key skills of reading, writing, listening, and speaking**. The EAS focus on academic content means that it provides solid preparation for externally assessed English Language exams such as IELTS and TOEFL. It also teaches practical academic skills which will help students to study more effectively.

The EITP also develops practical academic skills which will help students to study more effectively.

These include:

- Making effective presentations
- Listening for detail and note-taking
- Using subject-specific academic vocabulary
- Writing in an appropriate academic register
- Organising and planning written assignments
- Essay structure and planning
- Developing techniques for reading academic texts quickly and accurately
- Developing independent learning strategies

PASTORAL CARE

Insworld places much **emphasis on treating each student as an individual**. This can be seen in our approach to teaching and learning, but it also enables us to offer personalised guidance and support to students on academic and non-academic matters.

Insworld welcomes students from a broad range of educational backgrounds. Students who have learning differences or who may be deemed vulnerable will be interviewed by our Special Education Needs Consultant, to determine how we can help the student to learn more effectively. This can extend to regular sessions in which matters such as organisation, time management and study skills can be reviewed as well as academic progress. Good communication with parents is essential in such instances.

The EITP and EAS groups have a teacher assigned to them to supervise their academic progress, who will also be available to discuss any pastoral matter that may be affecting a student's well-being.

Small class sizes mean that teachers will notice if a student appears to be struggling with their academic work or life in school. We believe that early intervention is the most effective way to stop small problems becoming more serious. Pastoral as well as academic matters are frequently raised in our weekly Teachers' Meeting, allowing us to share concerns and also to discuss the most effective strategies to help the student. This could lead to extra academic support and/or pastoral guidance.

A-Level students all have a teacher appointed as their **Personal Tutor** – one of their subject teachers whom they meet each week to review academic progress and discuss any other matter that may be a cause for concern for the school or for the student. It is an important opportunity for academic or other issues to be raised discreetly and discussed openly.

Any intervention which is recommended is recorded, and its effectiveness in helping the student resolve the problem is evaluated. The focus at all times is on doing what we can to help the student to improve their performance in school.



OUR PHILOSOPHY

The Insworld philosophy is to adapt our work to meet our students' needs, taking into consideration their differences as young people and young learners. We offer **flexibility in enrolment dates and subject choices**. We will always seek to accommodate every student and enrol them on the best programme for their continuing academic development. This can be important for local and international students who want to switch schools in the middle of the academic year. The Pearson Edexcel International GCSE and IAL exams are compatible with this approach.

Our way of working allows us to promote the development of each student as an independent learner who can think critically and creatively about problems. This is done through working only with **small classes (4-12 students)**. Our aim is to bring out the best from individual students who come from different backgrounds and who have different learning styles. Insworld offers a range of programmes, from EITP (Lower Secondary/Key Stage 3), through International GCSE (O-Level) to A-Level/International A-Level. These are designed to provide a coherent high school education that will qualify students for entry to a leading university in Singapore or overseas.

Our aim is to combine the best of the Asian and the Western approaches to education. We want students to maintain a scholastic discipline that will allow them to focus on key learning objectives. However, we also want our students to be actively engaged in their classes at every level; asking questions, clarifying doubts, exploring ideas, evaluating alternatives. We adapt our approach to match the ways our students learn. **The intellectual development of each individual student is the focal point of our work.** Because we know our students well, we can find the most effective ways to work with them to promote learning and academic achievement.



PROFESSIONAL SUPPORT

Personalised Support

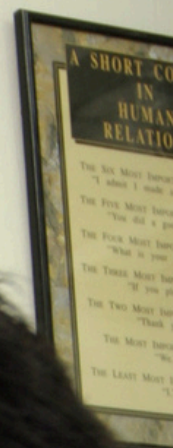
Insworld supports students outside the classroom. We appoint a Personal Tutor for each IAL student, who will monitor all aspects of that student's progress. Students meet their Personal Tutor every week. This is an important opportunity to give the school feedback and to raise concerns. This could be especially important for international students who may be new to living and studying in Singapore. If we identify any deep-rooted academic problems that require extra work, we arrange, at no extra cost, one-to-one sessions with the subject teacher to understand the problem and work towards a solution.

Careers and University Counselling

Insworld staff have extensive experience of helping students prepare their applications for places at university – in Singapore and overseas. This includes helping students decide on the right university and the right course, assisting them with preparing their personal statements, providing documentation and other support to help them manage the application process. Students who are likely to be called for interview will be offered mock interviews in different formats.

SEN Support

Our Special Needs Consultant works proactively to support our students and their families. In addition to measures we can implement in school, we want to cooperate as closely as possible with families, guardians and other professionals so that the student receives coherent and consistent support at home and at school. When we have students with identified learning differences, we will make sure that teachers are aware of their challenges, and that lesson content and delivery are adapted to give all students the best opportunity to learn.



CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES

At Insworld Institute, we believe in the holistic development of our students. While achieving excellent exam grades has to be the main focus of our work, we understand how extra-curricular activities (ECAs) play an important role in promoting social and cultural development. This in turn can lead to a more confident, focused and mature approach to studying and learning.

Other than during exam periods, we try each week to give students the chance to take part in a range of activities. These can include team sports such as basketball and futsal, and individual sports such as badminton. Sport can have many lessons for life. Students can learn through their own experience how to manage complex group dynamics including cooperation, mutual support, leadership, communication and the importance of knowing when to take responsibility and when to share it. Sport can also help develop individual traits such as resilience, determination, the ability to channel competitiveness productively and an understanding of how to respond appropriately to winning and losing.

ECAs are fun and good for fitness, but also allow students to get to know each other outside the classroom, and to appreciate each other's abilities and talents . We also have a number of clubs which allow students to practice and share their enthusiasms. These can be seen in a range of activities such as yoga, photography, hiking, visits to museums and galleries, our English Language Club and many other opportunities to take part and share interests.

These activities are important for social cohesion and cooperation, and as such help to promote the holistic development of the students. However, they are also an opportunity to enjoy taking part, meeting new people, exploring new directions and learning or refining skills.



LEADERSHIP AND TEAM-BUILDING

Insworld Institute places great emphasis on leadership and teamwork, equipping students with vital skills for success in the modern world. Our annual leadership event is a key part of this commitment, providing students with immersive experiences designed to enhance their social and interpersonal skills. Students learn effective communication, collaboration, and problem-solving, enabling them to become competent and empathetic leaders.

The leadership event helps to develop a sense of community through promoting positive and mutually supportive relationships. These allow students develop not only academically but also socially.

At Insworld Institute, we want our students to graduate with academic knowledge and qualifications, as well as the interpersonal skills necessary for success in their future careers and personal lives. We want our graduates to become responsible and effective global citizens.

OUTREACH ACTIVITIES

We encourage our students to actively engage with the wider community. Insworld Institute places a strong emphasis on nurturing well-rounded individuals. Our commitment to this holistic development is exemplified through our outreach activities and community projects.

Through these outreach programs, Insworld students develop their understanding of social responsibility and become more aware of how they can contribute positively to society.
